Are you a business with multiple locations interested in a secure, private network?

Then you would be looking for a **Private Network**.

This is for businesses with multiple locations interested in creating a secure, private network between sites using fiber optic strands dedicated for that purpose.

A few examples of businesses this would include: a bank with many branches, a real estate business with offices in several locations around a county or around the region; a commercial operation with one or more storefronts, a warehouse, and a garage; medical offices around the region.

Benefits Include:

- ✓ Flexibility and Security: Dedicated fiber optics enables your business to manage bandwidth capacity being limited only by the electronics your enterprise uses to light the fiber.
- ✓ Cost Savings: By linking together the remote and central sites, your company can concentrate all voice, data and Internet traffic to a central location, potentially reducing monthly telecommunications costs.
- ✓ Disaster Recovery: Your business can use the fiber to establish a diverse connection for disaster recovery.
